## INTRODUCTION

Year in, year out, the Adventist University of Central Africa admits students from all walk of life for their dream specializations. Admission processes can vary widely depending on mainly the program one is applying to. Since sometimes admission processes can be highly competitive, prospective candidates are always advised to start early, meet all deadlines, and put effort into preparing a strong application. Additionally, it is good to communicate with the AUCA admission team in the office of the Registrar to ensure that the applicants have the most up-to-date information about their admission requirements and processes. The policy at hand elaborates more on how admission is done at AUCA.

## Philosophy

The Adventist University of Central Africa operates on the basis of the Seventh-day Adventist worldview, which holds that God is the Creator and Sustainer of the universe and the source of true knowledge. The entrance of sin caused man's alienation from God, therefore the restoration of the relation between man and God is the main aim of the Christian Education that leads students to discover and understand the truth through critical thinking.

## Mission

The mission of the Adventist University of Central Africa (AUCA) is to provide Christ-centered wholistic quality education to prepare for service in this world, and in the life to come.

## Vision

The vision of the Adventist University of Central Africa (AUCA) is to become an international center of academic learning with global impact.

## Beliefs and Values

AUCA is a Seventh-day Adventist institution of higher learning that nurtures the mental, spiritual, social and physical capacities of its personnel and students. The values of the University are rooted in the Bible and should be seen in the daily activities of the university administrators, workers, and students.

Through a process of discernment based on dialogue, critical thinking, and reflection, university designates the following as core beliefs and values of AUCA:

## AUCA Accreditation

The university operates under the charter from the Ministry of Education of the Government of Rwanda, through Higher Education Council (HEC) and as such it is empowered to offer its programmes and confer appropriate degrees. The institution has reciprocal arrangements to recognize its degrees and diplomas from other accredited universities both within the country and elsewhere. Denominationally, the university holds accreditation from Adventist Accrediting Association (AAA) of the Seventh-day Adventist Schools, Colleges, and Universities worldwide.

## ADMISSIONS

Undergraduate
Students are recruited from A Level secondary school leavers and applicants from other accredited institutions of higher learning.

The applicant must submit the following documents:
i.A fully completed application form, which may be obtained from the Registrar's Office or apply online.
ii.A certified copy of the A Level certificate with two principal passes. (For candidates applying to the Nursing programme, two principal passes are required in Biology and Chemistry and a minimum of a subsidiary pass in Math or Physics)
iii. Two recent passport size photographs.
iv. A copy of the national ID card or passport.
v. A payment slip of the application fee (non-refundable).
vi. A copy of valid health insurance.
vii. Medical certificate and police clearance for Nursing and Education
viii. Take the English Placement Test or present the proof of an English standardized test score (e.g. TOEFL, IELTS, etc).

Note: International students start the registration process after fulfilling the requirements from the National Examination and School Inspection Authority (NESA) requiring them to get the Equivalence of their credentials from REB.

After international students have received admission into the programme they are immediately required to get student visas from Immigration Office.
A student who does not score $70 \%$ and above in the English Placement Test will be required to undergo a non-credit short course of English Proficiency Certificate and pass it before he/she can graduate from AUCA. Pass/Fail/Waive will be mentioned on the transcript. The student will be awarded an English Proficiency Certificate upon successfully meeting the requirements of the course (test, registration, attendance, and assessment).

## Note:

- Midway or transfer students from an accredited institution are admitted based on their competences (transcripts) in previous area of study.
- Applicant who failed / does not have Mathematics will sit for a placement test of Mathematics to test his/her level of mathematics. He/she will be admitted with $50 \%$ as pass mark in entrance exam.
- Applicant with equivalence that does not shows subjects passed, admission will be based on the aggregate, combination and $\mathrm{S} 4, \mathrm{~S} 5$ and S 6 (three last years) major subjects studied with an average pass mark $50 \%$.


## Graduate

a. The following are requirements for admission into Masters programme:

- A well filled in application form
- Certified photocopies of college or university diplomas or degree certificates
- Two recent passport-size photos
- Three letters of recommendation from referees in sealed envelopes
- Two certified copies of the official transcript from each college/ university attended (certified by the institution or Commissioner of Oath)
- Certified photocopy of secondary school certificate
- Updated curriculum vitae (CV)
- A proof/copy of health insurance certificate
- Essay (Explaining educational goals, career objectives, work experience, awards, and/or extracurricular activities)
b. A student is required to have a degree recognized and offered by institution of higher learning in order to qualify for admission in master's program
c. International applicants will be required to fulfil the aforementioned requirements and obtain a student visa from the Government of Rwanda as well as the equivalence of the Bachelor's Degree from High Education Council (HEC) in Rwanda.
